



INDEPENDENCE TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY PARK OPEN BURNING GUIDELINES



- ✓ Open burning in the park must be pre-approved by Township officials.
- ✓ Open fires must be in a container, with bottom and sides so that no ash or debris is left on the ground.
- ✓ Open fires must have adult (18 or over) supervision at all times.
- ✓ Open fires must be at least 25 ft. from any structure including but not limited to pavilion, playset, port-o-john, etc.
- ✓ Open fires are to be used for cooking food or recreational fellowship only – not for burning picnic trash or papers.
- ✓ Open fire residue and ashes left over after fire is put out may not be left behind or dumped on any public property (park, school, fire department or township grounds or along the creek bank); and may not be placed in the township dumpster with bagged trash.
- ✓ Patrons need to bring a metal container to take the ashes home for disposal.
