

Did you know???

Although Pennsylvania does not charge the gas companies a severance tax like other states, the gas companies instead are required to pay an Unconventional Gas Well Impact Fee. A significant portion of that fee gets disbursed directly to the municipalities affected by the gas



wells instead of it all going to the state to distribute. To date, Independence Township has received \$56,000 in Impact Fee monies from gas companies that have been put directly back into the township's roads and recreation. It is not a lot of money, but for our small community, it makes a huge difference. So, don't think the gas companies are not paying taxes, they are just paying us directly and you will see the effects!
